Positive Score: (0,1)

Negative Score: (0,1)

Objectivity Score = $1 - (\text{Positive} + \text{Negative})$

Only utilized Positivity/Negativity in this project

Implementation

- 1) Extract average scores of a word.
- 2) Get an averaged score for a line.
- 3) For each score, choose the corresponding Image.
- 4) Sum up the RGB values, then average them. Thus generate a new Image.

Examples:

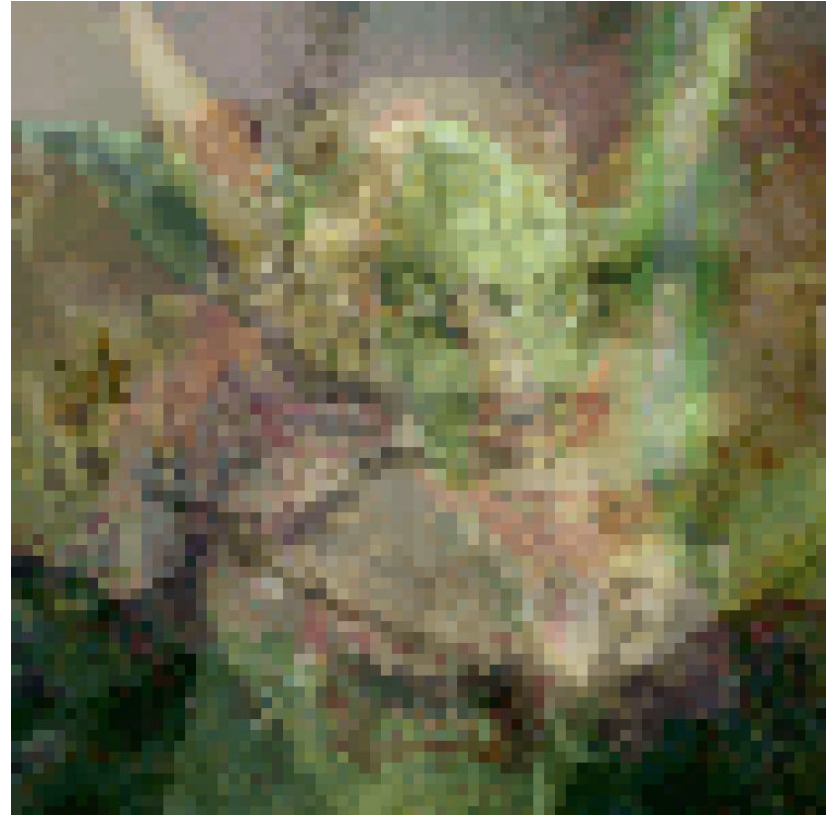

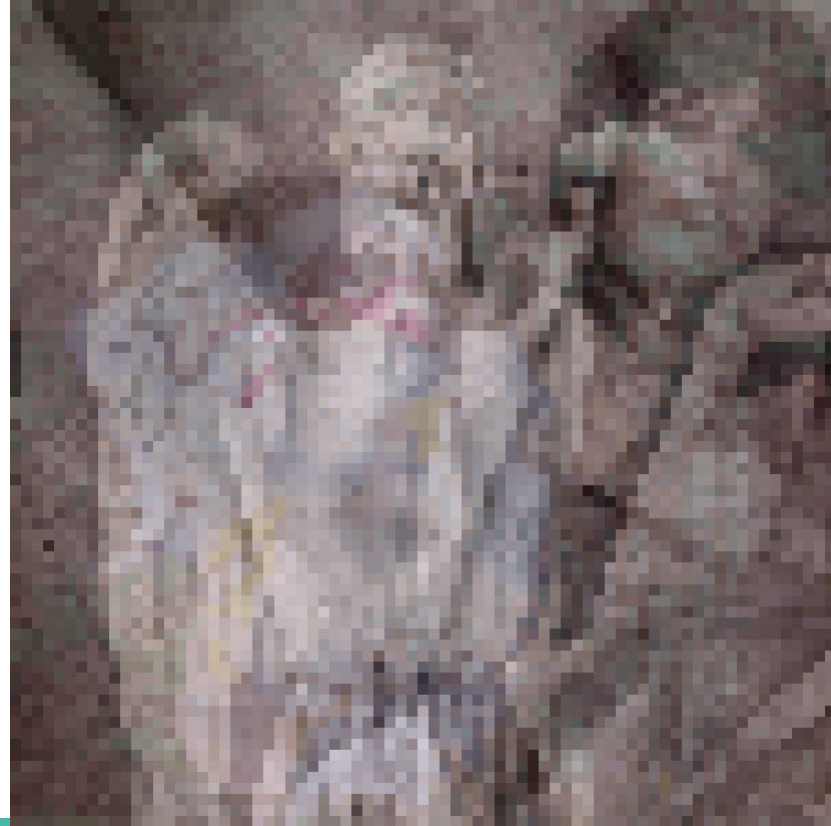
